Operate tractors, mowers, and chainsaws (equipment use and maintenance); learn inoculation techniques (plant pathology), seedling care (greenhouse management and horticulture), and silvicultural techniques (forestry); and perform data collection, entry, and analysis (research). Work will be 50/50 inside and outside.

Applications are due by January 20th! Work period will be 10 weeks. Beginning May 1st (flexible) through August, with potential work through the fall semester.



Qualifications: Must be motivated, dependable, organized, and observant. Applicants should be 18 years of age and possess a valid driver's license. Some experience with mowers/equipment is a plus but not required. Students from any major are encouraged to apply.
